Recycling and purchasing products made with recycled materials will conserve resources and the environment.

Sustainable Purchasing

Look for products made with post-consumer recycled material, this means it is made from products that have been used by individuals or businesses.

Paper products, such as office paper, paper towel, toilet paper and cardboard made with post-consumer recycled content are now readily available.
