I would like to correct the assertion made in Larry Pynn's December 22nd frontpage story in which he writes that the Recycling Council of B.C. (RCBC) "currently recommends just two e-waste companies" involved in the reuse or recycling of e-waste. The fact is there are more than 80 e-waste-related organizations within the RCBC database which callers to the RCBC toll-free Recycling Hotline are referred, depending on the type of materials and the caller's community. These include both Computers for Schools and Genesis Recycling, but not exclusively so.
