A nominee for an environmental award must have demonstrated:

- ❖ Actions that reduce, resolve, or avoid environmental challenges
- ❖ Promotion of public awareness
- ❖ Consistent and responsible environmental management practices

The Awards Committee will also be considering:

- ❖ Length of service
- ❖ Commitment to environmental protection
- ❖ Innovative approach to environmental enhancement

What are the Categories and Criteria?

Individual Citizens – Citizens who have contributed to the stewardship of the environment.

Youth – Individuals or groups under the age of 21 who have made extra-ordinary contributions to environmental issues.

Public Sector – Governments or their employees who have demonstrated excellence in the environmental field.

Private Sector – Organizations or their employees with outstanding initiatives to preserve and protect our environment.

Educators – Outstanding achievements by organizations or individuals in the field of education on environmental topics.

Non-Profit Organizations – Organizations providing services beyond expectations in environmental stewardship.

Journalists and Media – Journalism that contributes to the public understanding of environmental sustainability, recycling and waste reduction.

Innovation Award - individual or company that achieves an outstanding technical accomplishment in design or development of a product or process that improves its sustainability or advances zero waste practices
